

Arthroscopic Ankle Surgery Instructions

- 1. Do not drink or eat anything after midnight before surgery. No gum or mints the morning of surgery. Do not taking any medications that can thin the blood (Motrin/Ibuprofen, Aleve/Naproxyn, Aspirin, Coumadin) for at least 5 days before surgery.
- 2. Someone will need to drive you home after the surgery.
- 3. You may use an ice pack 3-5 times/day for swelling/pain. Make sure to protect your skin from direct contact with the ice (eg cloth).
- 4. You may remove dressings 2 days after surgery. You may shower 7 days after surgery. You may submerge the ankle in a bath/pool/hot tub 14 days after surgery.
- 5. Contact the office (805-286-4416) if you are having trouble with pain control, vomiting, or fevers/chills.
- 6. As soon as you are comfortable, you may start range of motion exercises, in particular spelling out the alphabet 3 times daily with your foot in the air.
